

What you receive if a message is encrypted

Note: If your message (the sender) should NOT REQUIRE encryption, it is routed directly to the recipient unchanged.

What causes your message to be encrypted:

- **Activation 1 (Force Encrypt)** - Typing the words **"Secure:"** or **"Encrypt:"** will trigger a secure message delivery.
- **Activation 2 (Content Encrypt)** - All of your outgoing message are automatically tested to determine if there might be HIPAA protected information included. If HIPAA Policy triggers are activated, the message is sent securely.

How your informed that your recipient is receiving a secure message:

- **If your message is encrypted** - You the sender will receive a 'Your message was encrypted' email (see below). This email has VERY USEFUL information about encrypted message, such as subject, date and time.
